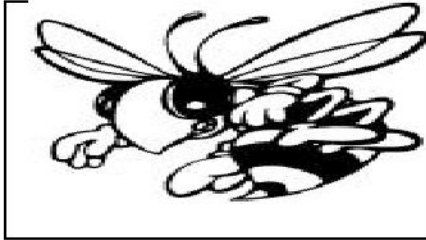

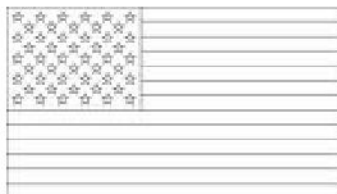
Boxtops4Education: Do your internet shopping through www.boxtops4education.com, and vendors give money to our schools.
