

SPECIAL AND EMERGENCY MEETINGS

The Chairperson or any two members may call a special meeting of the Mansfield School Committee by serving on the other members a notice of the time and place of the meeting at least 48 hours before the hour of meeting. Said notice will indicate the reason for holding such special meeting. Committee members will transact no other business, except if the Committee votes unanimously to do so.

The Committee will use the same procedures for publicizing and conducting special meetings as for regular meetings except as noted in Paragraph 1.

In case of the need for an emergency meeting, the law recognizes that it may not be possible for the School Committee to follow the procedures for notice and posting.

State Open Meeting law defines “Emergency” as “a sudden, generally unexpected occurrence or set of circumstances demanding immediate action.”
