Education Services Plan

In accordance with Massachusetts General Laws Ch. 71, Sections 37H, 37H1/2 and 37H3/4, the Mansfield Public School District must provide opportunities for students to earn credits, make up assignments, tests and other school work as needed to make academic progress during a period in which the student is suspended. Furthermore, the district shall develop an educational services plan for any student expelled or on long term suspended from school for more than 10 consecutive school days.

The following educational services may include, but are not limited to:

- Web-based Academic Services
- Tutoring Services

It is the responsibility of the principal or designee to notify and identify, in collaboration with the parents/guardians, the educational services necessary for the student to continue to make academic progress as compared with all students. Once an educational service plan is established and implemented for a student, it is the responsibility of the principal or designee to verify student enrollment and participation.
